









Do not overload electrical sockets







Do not charge phones or devices overnight



Use washers, dryers and dishwashers during the day when you are at home











Keep kitchens clean and tidy




Keep scarves, long hair and loose clothing away from cooking flames and pans




Switch ovens and hobs off after use






Make sure candles and cigarettes are properly extinguished
