2.2 This is the total number of incidents attended by TWFRS within the Sunderland District over the 2022/23 fiscal year (1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023).

The data is broken down into the three main incident types – Fires, Special Services and False Alarms, then by ward.

3.4 False Alarms by Ward. False alarms consist of:-

FAA (False Alarm Apparatus) These are calls initiated by fire alarm and fire-fighting equipment operating which are usually smoke or heat alarms activating in public or private buildings.

FAGI (false alarm good intent). These are calls made in good faith in the belief that the FRS really would attend an incident.

FAM (false alarm malicious). Are calls made with the intention of getting the FRS to attend a non-existent incident, including deliberate and suspected malicious intentions.
